6	<p>SURVEY ON NAIROBI SHOPPING CENTRES</p> <p>The survey is in the form of a questionnaire conducted between ca. 1971 and 1972 but some only indicate the month but not the year. Each questionnaire indicates the name of the shopping centre, the social status of the shoppers who frequent the place (this is indicated by means of transport they employ and the quantity of money spent etc) and relates the basic problems encountered. Different individuals acted as investigators under the supervision of Mrs. S.M. Kimani.</p> <p>The shopping centres covered are indicated below in an alphabetical sequence. ABC shopping centre, Altering (?) Adams Arcade, Bahati East, Bahati West, Bondeni, Broadway stores, Caldedonia Market, Dagoretti corner, Dagoretti shops, Donholm, Eastleigh, Gatina (?) Hamza road, Hurlingham, Jericho, Kabete provision stores, Kangemi centre, Kangemi West, Kaloleni, Kanungaga, Karen, Karen Market, Kariobangi, Kawangware, Kawangware East, Kenya Breweries, Kibera, KIA, Lavington Green, Lumumba, Maisha, Makadara, Makongeni, Muthangari, Maringo, Nairobi South C,N.A, Laboratory centre, NITD, Otiende Estate, Pangani, Highway, Parklands, Parklands 5th Ave., Parklands Scalaters Road, Riruta, Shauri Moyo, South B, South C, (upto 47) Uhuru and Juja Rd, Uthiru, Valley Arcade, Waithaka, Westlands, West, Ziwani.</p> <p>Most of these questionnaires are numbered but some numbers are not consecutive others are not numbered at all. There is an average of about 40 questionnaires for each centre covered.
